In January, we tackled a big project by disassembling 51 pews to create additional space in the warehouse for incoming donations. Throughout February, we facilitated a money transfer to Bro. Danny White in Vanuatu for the shipment of bible study material. We were also delighted to have Bro. Walt and Sis. Maggie Emry as well as Bro. Kuni visit the warehouse for discussion and final touches before their respective shipments¹. Later in February, we made a \$14,000 purchase from U-Line to improve warehouse operations. On February 27th, we loaded Bro. Kuni's 20-foot container to be shipped to Brazil for his move to the mission field². Then on March 5th, we loaded Bro. Walt's crate to be shipped to Vanuatu³. We also began our first annual Hygiene Kit Drive on Feb. 1st, and the response has been overwhelming. Thank you to all who have supported this effort!

March brought some complications. Our office computer's hard drive failed, but thanks to Bro. Luke Adam's help from our sponsoring church, we were able to build a much needed new PC as our last one was old. We also had our forklift operated on. With the help of local volunteers Bros.
