Though things have been a little quieter at the warehouse recently, God is still actively at work!

We're so grateful for the consistent donations, from pianos to medical supplies and more.¹ However, **we still need Bibles**. We appreciate recent donations! Bibles are included in almost all of our shipments, so the need is constant. Please deliver or ship new or used Bibles (with cover, readable, and no missing pages) to our warehouse.

The tree damage repairs are almost 100% complete,² with just some minor electrical work left, handled by my dad. Now, our focus is on the forklift. The brakes haven't worked, a vital issue. The technician found both brake assemblies, the emergency brake, the master cylinder, and a brake line need replacing. The initial quote was \$2,858.86. We're awaiting parts, but glad repairs are underway!

On a personal note, Hannah and I are thrilled to announce we're expecting our **second baby girl** in late August! ³ Evelynn is excited to play with her baby sister, and we're anxious to meet her. Please pray for the baby's development and our family as we grow.

We're currently planning to ship a crate of hygiene kits and books to Brother Livingstone Lambert in Tanzania, Africa, and a container to Brother Julio Anzora in El Salvador. Celebrating 30 Years of Ministry!













This year marks 30 years since the inception of this ministry! It began in 1995 when my grandfather and former Director, Joel Meredith, took a trip to Jamaica. While there, he encountered a church that had been using old Sunday School literature from Bogard, and they had gone through the material multiple times. After my grandfather was asked if they could get more literature, he returned home with an idea. He brought the idea before the church he pastored at the time, Calvary MBC in Hamburg, AR, which became and still is our sponsoring church today. The initial name of the ministry was World-Wide Literature Project, because that's just what it was - a project. Calvary began receiving excess literature from churches all over the country. After everything was organized by age and quartlerly, the literature would be placed in mail bags and shipped via USPS across the globe. Operations ran out of the church's fellowship hall, but it wouldn't take long to outgrow that space. So, Calvary built a small warehouse across the street from the church, and after outgrowing that space, we added onto that warehouse. But God kept blessing, and a larger space was required still. In 2003, we purchased a 15,000 square foot warehouse that we still use today. As God continued to bless, the ministry grew. We went from shipping literature in mailbags to shipping building materials, machinery, vehicles, and much more via crates and containers. I joined the ministry as Assistant Director in 2018, and after learning the ropes under my grandfather for a few years, I became Director as my grandfather left this ministry to pastor a Church in 2022. Today, I am in awe of all that God has done in my life and this ministry. Our efforts would be in vain without Him, and we couldn't have gotten here without the faithful servants He put alongside us. We thank anyone who has ever supported us to any degree, be it through financial support, donations, labor, encouragement, time, prayers, anything. We couldn't have done it without you.
