The past 3 months were busy and productive months here at the warehouse! We had many visitors, many donations, and drove many, many miles.

National Meeting

Hannah and I were blessed to be able to attend the National ABA Meeting in Spokane, WA. We brought our daughter, Evelyn, too. We had many conversations there while representing the ministry, and I believe some of those conversations might lead to future shipping projects if the Lord wills.

We also decided to drive to the meeting, making it a once-in-a-lifetime road trip. In total, we drove well over 5,000 miles, spent over 70 hours on the road, visited 4 national parks, saw 1 national monument, and hit 16 states all in 11 days. It was an amazing and chaotic time away with family, and I thank God for the opportunity and safety!

Donations

In fear of leaving an individual or church out, I'll refrain from listing everyone, but I'd like to thank everyone who spent the effort, time, money, and miles to gather supplies and get them to us for shipping. We recently received chairs, Bibles, hygiene kits, study books, hymnals, and medical equipment like two examination tables and even two ultrasound machines! We have another ultrasound machine waiting to be donated. I suppose God wants us to ship some medical equipment somewhere soon. I don't know who, when, or where, but He does!

We've also been receiving things for ICP's upcoming shipment for Bro. Bill Johnson. Many have sent us backpacks for ICP's BackPack ministry. If you have any backpacks for this container, please contact me or Bro. Bill Johnson. We are planning to ship the container in late November or early December.

Other Projects

We recently shipped a crate to Tonga and plan to ship another crate to Peru soon. I am hoping to ship Bro. Walt Emry his container around November, and I have also been talking with Bro. Danny White in Vanuatu about some shipments! Please be in prayer for these projects.

Shipment for Bro. Livingstone Lambert

We're also working on a 40' container shipment for Bro. Livingstone Lambert in Tanzania, Africa. Bro. Livingstone and Bro. Joe Hellums visited the warehouse the day after we returned from our road trip. It was great to finally meet those men face to face. Bro. Jared and I had a great time fellowshiping with them. We talked about the upcoming shipment, and Bro. Livingstone shared a list of needs. He specifically mentioned the need for church and school furnishings like **tables, chairs, school desks, pulpits, communion tables, and even pews***. We normally don't accept pews due to limited storage capacity, but we're willing to ship pews if we can get them in and out quickly. However, we've recently learned a better way to handle pews – take them apart! For reference, there are currently 12 pews, 10' long, disassembled on a pallet in the warehouse. They are occupying roughly a 4'x4'x10' spot off to the side. These pews would normally be placed directly in our staging zone (out of necessity) in four rows of three pews taking up about 6'x3'x40'. If you have any questions regarding this, please contact me.
